PURPOSE: As you may be aware, in 2014 due to financial constraints, Logan CDC the Community Development Organization for the Logan Neighborhood closed its doors. Before the CDC closed it had started an important community-based neighborhood planning process to guide future development and be used as the unified voice of the community moving forward. Unfortunately that plan was never completed.

The Philadelphia Redevelopment Authority (PRA) owns the +40 acre Logan Triangle. The PRA is supporting completion of the Logan Comprehensive Neighborhood Plan prior to moving forward with plans to identify a developer for the Logan Triangle site.
